

OHSAA football scores, Highland vs. Revere high school recap, highlights

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BATH TWP. — [Casey Myser](#) broke the Medina County record for rushing touchdowns and [Highland](#) won at least a share of the Suburban League American Conference title with a 49-7 victory over Revere on Oct. 17.

Myser finished with 101 yards and two touchdowns on 12 carries to lead the Hornets (9-0, 6-0) to their second consecutive league title.

It was all Highland in the first half, when the Hornets blitzed the Minutemen (6-2, 4-2) with four touchdowns on a 60-yard punt return for a score, a 2-yard fumble return by Dan Miller, a 14-yard touchdown pass from Grady Gibb to Evan Foust and a 2-yard score by Dylan Lazar.

Foust scored another 14-yard touchdown on a pass from Gibb to finish the scoring in the third quarter.

Brady Hajdu scored from a yard out for Revere with 8:27 left in the fourth quarter.

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Harrison Drvenkar rushed for 29 yards on 12 carries and had two catches for 30 yards to lead Revere.

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Revere on the board against Highland

Brady Hajdu scored from a yard out for the Minutemen. It's 49-7 Highland with 8:27 left.

Deja vu all over again for Highland

Evan Foust scored his second 14-yard touchdown on a pass from Grady Gibb. It's 49-0 Highland with 3:06 left in the third quarter. Both of Foust's touchdowns came on third down.

The senior's 2-yard rushing touchdown gave him 73 for his career and broke Black River graduate Andrew Vaughn. It's 35-0 with 5:15 left in the second quarter.

Highland scores on the ground against Revere

The Hornets capped off a seven-play, 55-yard drive that took 3:37 off the clock with a 2-yard

touchdown by Dylan Lazar. It's 28-0 Highland with 40 seconds left in the first quarter. That's how the quarter ends.

Highland has a 99 to minus-14 edge in total offense.

Highland up three scores already over Revere

The Hornets gave up just seven yards on the opening drive to force a kick by Donovan Juby. Lucas Gerding took the punt at Highland's 40 and returned it 60 yards for a touchdown. It's 7-0 Highland with 9:38 left in the first quarter.

Highland vs. Revere football, recent history

The Hornets haven't lost to Revere since a 24-7 defeat on Sept. 25, 2009. During the current 14-game winning streak, Highland has scored over 41 points six times. The Hornets have also shut out the Minutemen five times in the same span, including a 41-0 win in 2024 and 49-0 victory in 2022.

Highland football players to watch

Highland running back Casey Myser last week broke the Medina County career touchdown record previously held by Black River's Andrew Vaughn. He now has 83 touchdowns overall, and he's tied with Vaughn for the career rushing touchdown record (72). ... There's a four-headed attack on offense for Highland with Myser (90 carries, 756 yards, 16 TDs), Grady Gibb (60-of-70 passing, 1,123 yards, 20 TDs; 51 carries, 441 yards, five TDs), Lucas Gerding (18 catches, 318 yards, three TDs) and Nick Dobkowski (11 catches, 270 yards, three TDs).

Revere football players to watch

James Perry (71 carries, 364 yards, 11 TDs) and Harrison Drvenkar (36 carries, 281 yards, three TDs) have filled Revere's running game after the injury loss of Johlil Blanchard, who had 451 yards and three TDs on 63 yards. Chase Clifford (35-of-72 passing, 554 yards, eight TDs) keeps defenses honest. Drvenkar (17 catches, 289 yards, five TDs) is his main receiver. ... Nick Hall (72 tackles, four for loss, two sacks, four interceptions, five pass breakups, fumble recovery, forced fumbles) continues to dominate at linebacker for the Minutemen. ... David Kennedy (24 of 25 on PATs, field goals) is nearly automatic on special teams.
