Highland Quarterback

Class: Senior.
Height: 6-foot. **Weight:** 185.
Highlights: Division II second-team All-Northeast Inland District. ... First-team All-Suburban League American Conference. ... Completed 113-of-155 passes (729) and broke school records with 2,303 yards and 27 touchdowns. ... Was 13-for-13 for 232 yards and two scores in playoff win against Whitehouse Anthony Wayne. ... Overcame two ACL tears in career.
Hornets coach Mike Gibbons on Borla: "He will go down as one of the best quarterbacks to ever play at Highland. He led by example and always put his teammates first."




CASEY MYSER

Height: 6-foot-2. **Weight:** 205.
Highlights: Division II first-team All-Ohio. ... First-team All-Northeast Inland District. ... Suburban League American Conference Offensive Player of Year. ... Broke Medina County records for touchdowns (46) and points (276) in season. ... Had 254 carries for 2,130 yards and 21 catches for 558 yards. ... Rushed for school-record 320 yards in three quarters against Revere.
Hornets coach Mike Gibbons on Myser: "Casey is the perfect blend of size, speed and power. He makes it look easy and effortless when it is far from that."




TROY MCCANN
Buckeye Runningback

Class: Senior.
Height: 5-foot-9. **Weight:** 201.
Highlights: Division III first-team All-Ohio. ... First-team All-Northeast Inland District. ... Cleveland West Conference Offensive Player of Year. ... Rushed 233 times for 1,892 yards and 32 touchdowns. ... Had six TDs vs. Cloverleaf and 299 rushing yards vs. North Olmsted. ... Among Medina County career leaders in rushing yards (3rd, 4,829), rushing TDs (2nd, 68), total TDs (3rd, 69) and points (3rd, 422).
Bucks coach Greg Dennison on McCann: "His strength, durability and speed combined with his work ethic made him a great player."




COOPER GRAY
Wadsworth Runningback

Class: Junior.
Height: 5-foot-11. **Weight:** 170.
Highlights: Division II honorable mention All-Ohio. ... First-team All-Northeast Inland District and Suburban League National Conference. ... Rushed 211 times for 1,673 yards, caught nine passes for 201 yards and scored 24 touchdowns despite sharing time with Gavin Madigan for half of season. ... Had 26 touches for 310 yards from scrimmage and three TDs in win over Solon.
Grizzlies coach Justin Todd on Gray: "An explosive runner with great strength and balance, he became the feature back Week 7 and beyond and is a viable threat catching the ball out of the backfield."




EVAN FOUST
Highland H-back

Class: Sophomore.
Height: 6-foot. **Weight:** 195.
Highlights: Division II second-team All-Northeast Inland District. ... First-team All-Suburban League American Conference. ... Caught 28 passes for 577 yards and five touchdowns, rushed 27 times for 242 yards and three scores, led team with 88 tackles (9 for loss, 4 sacks) and punted for 35.4 average (5 inside 20-yard line). ... Key blocker for offense that broke Medina County record for points (606).
Hornets coach Mike Gibbons on Foust: "To be that effective on both sides of the ball as a sophomore is amazing. The sky is the limit for Evan."




TREY WIDENMEYER
Buckeye Tight end

Class: Senior.
Height: 6-foot. **Weight:** 211.
Highlights: Division III first-team All-Ohio as punter. ... First-team All-Northeast Inland District. ... Cleveland West Conference Player of Year. ... Caught 24 passes for 567 yards and 12 touchdowns. ... Broke school career receiving records for catches (84), yards (1,599) and TDs (23). ... Had 46 tackles (12½ for loss, 2½ sacks) in first season at end.
Bucks coach Greg Dennison on Widenmeyer: "He dominated the line of scrimmage with his blocking and he also could get open in the seams to make big plays in the passing game."



GABE LUDTKE
Wadsworth Left guard

Class: Junior.
Height: 5-foot-10. **Weight:** 235.
Highlights: Division II honorable mention All-Northeast Inland District. ... First-team All-Suburban League National Conference. ... Powerful blocker for offense that averaged 37.5 points 385.8 yards. ... Especially punishing as puller on powers, traps and counters. ... Two-year starter.
Grizzlies coach Justin Todd on Ludtke: "Our most physical lineman, Gabe is the primary puller in our gap scheme. He delivers a powerful punch on trap blocks and moves his feet really well in pass protection."




RYAN GRAVES
Black River Left guard

Class: Senior.
Height: 6-foot-2. **Weight:** 235.
Highlights: Division VI honorable mention All-Ohio. ... First-team All-Northeast Inland District and Lorain County League. ... Top blocker for offense that averaged 27.8 points and 325.4 yards over final five games. ... Led Medina County linemen in tackles per game (6.4). ... Helped defense allow only 212.9 yards per game, second to Highland in Medina County. ... Four-year starter.
Pirates coach Kyle Clark on Graves: "Ryan is one of the most intelligent and accountable young men I've ever been around. He was constantly the first player at every lifting and practice."

Highlights: Division II honorable mention All-Northeast Inland District. ... First-team All-Suburban League American Conference. ... Mauling presence inside for team that broke Medina County record for points (606) while averaging 43.3 points and 427.4 yards. ... Standout puller on team's signature guard/H-back counter. ... Two-year starter. ... Standout heavyweight for wrestling team.
Hornets coach Mike Gibbons on Bendau: "Brady played the guard position like it should be. He was a 280-pound tank. He bends well and has tremendous feet."

Grizzlies coach Justin Todd on Kaufman: "'Big Country' continued to get technically better each day after missing his sophomore year due to injury. He is an extremely physical player, climbs to the second level incredibly well and has the athleticism to block in space."

Second season as starter. ... Holds offer from D-II Clarion.
Hornets coach Mike Gibbons on Coyne: "Ben was an unbelievable tackle for us. Ben blocked effectively well whether it was the run game or the pass game."

Height: 6-foot-1. **Weight:** 155.
Highlights: Division II honorable mention All-Northeast Inland District. ... Breakout star made 4-of-4 field goals, 70-of-73 extra points and put 47-of-89 kickoffs into end zone for touchdowns. ... Made 40-yard field goal in playoff victory over Fremont Ross. ... Opponents' average starting field position was Medina County-best 22.5-yard line. ... Honorable mention All-Gazette soccer player.
