Wadsworth Quarterback

Class: Sophomore.
 Height: 6-foot. Weight: 195.
Highlights: Division II first-team All-Ohio. ... First-team All-Northeast Inland District and Suburban League National Conference. ... Completed 139-of-215 passes for 2,490 yards, 29 touchdowns and four interceptions. ... Three 300-yard games. ... Already has 4,608 passing yards and 51 touchdowns in career. ... Also punted for 37.4 average.
Grizzlies coach Justin Todd on Hall: "Brysen's maturity, football IQ and leadership combined with the obvious physical talent make him one of the top QBs in Northeast Ohio with two years remaining."



CASEY MYER

Highland Running back

Class: Senior.
 Height: 5-foot-2. Weight: 215.
Highlights: Division II first-team All-Ohio. ... Northeast Inland District and Suburban League American Conference Offensive Player of Year. ... Had 1,462 yards from scrimmage (1,268 rushing, 194 receiving) and 27 touchdowns (162 points). ... Career totals of 5,702 yards from scrimmage (4,847 rushing, 855 receiving), 92 touchdowns and 552 points.
Hornets coach Mike Gibbons on Myer: "Everyone could see his ability on Friday nights. However, seeing what he poured into our program day in and day out will be what we all remember."



COOPER GRAY

Wadsworth Running

Class: Senior.
 Height: 5-foot-11. Weight: 170.
Highlights: Division II honorable mention All-Ohio. ... First-team All-Northeast Inland District and Suburban League National Conference. ... Had 156 carries for 1,189 yards and scored 18 total touchdowns. ... Rushed 385 times for 3,034 yards and 40 touchdowns while also catching 20 passes for 414 yards and four TDs for 264 total points in career.
Grizzlies coach Justin Todd on Gray: "Cooper's explosiveness in the open field was incredible. His ability to find the hole, make one cut and explode through the third level is as good as any player we've coached."

Wadsworth Receiver

Class: Senior.
 Height: 6-foot. Weight: 180.
Highlights: Division II first-team All-Ohio. ... First-team All-Northeast Inland District and Suburban League National Conference. ... Caught 46 passes for 999 yards and 15 touchdowns. ... Talled 28 tackles and 99-yard interception return for touchdown in first season at safety. ... Finished career with 88 catches, 1,729 yards, 27 total touchdowns, 128 tackles and 19 pass breakups.
Grizzlies coach Justin Todd on Lemp: "Calix is the most explosive athlete I've ever coached. It's no mistake he's the most sought-after recruit we've had other than NFL player Mitchell Evans."



ZANE BUNGARD

Black River Wide receiver

Class: Senior.
 Height: 6-foot-3. Weight: 190.
Highlights: Division VI first-team All-Ohio. ... Northeast Inland District D-VI Defensive Player of Year. ... Lorain County League Offensive Player of Year. ... Led Medina County with school records for catches (63) and yards (1,051) while also hauling in 14 touchdowns. ... Talled 11-256-3 line vs. Wellington. ... Had 67 tackles (7 for loss) and three fumble recoveries as outside linebacker.
Pirates coach Kyle Clark on Bungard: "At 6-3, 190, he made an impact at both wide receiver and outside linebacker and created problems for every team we faced."



LUCAS GERDING

Highland Wide receiver

Class: Senior.
 Height: 5-foot-10. Weight: 185.
Highlights: Division II second-team All-Northeast Inland District. ... First-team All-Suburban League American Conference. ... Caught 31 passes for 550 yards and six touchdowns and rushed 23 times for 218 yards and score. ... Had career-high 105 receiving yards vs. Talmadge. ... Career total of 2,152 all-purpose yards (669 rushing, 1,016 receiving, 477 returning).
Hornets coach Mike Gibbons on Gerding: "Lucas was the perfect slot receiver for our program. For what we want to do at that position, he was able to be a hybrid running back/receiver."



JOSH MESSINA

Highland Left tackle

Class: Senior.
 Height: 6-foot. Weight: 260.
Highlights: Division II honorable mention All-Northeast Inland District. ... First-team All-Suburban League American Conference. ... Lone returning starter on offensive line for team that averaged school-record 44.5 points, as well as 402.9 yards. ... Had eight tackles (1½ for loss, sack) as part-time defensive lineman.
Hornets coach Mike Gibbons on Messina: "Josh played on the offensive line the right way. He played the position violently and enjoyed contact. Josh was also very smart and understood our blocking schemes and how to communicate to everyone else."



JORDAN JONES

Wadsworth Left tackle

Class: Senior.
 Height: 6-foot-3. Weight: 250.
Highlights: Division II second-team All-Northeast Inland District. ... First-team All-Suburban League National Conference. ... Top blocker for team that averaged 43.8 points on Medina County-leading 434.6 yards. ... Made key holes for 1,000-yard rushers Gavin Madigan and Cooper Gray. ... Second season as starter.
Grizzlies coach Justin Todd on Jones: "He consistently graded out at the top of our line, only allowed one sack as a senior and developed himself into a very physical blocker in the run game, paving the way for two 1,000-yard rushers."



CODY BENDAUI

Highland Right guard

Class: Senior.
 Height: 5-foot-11. Weight: 245.
Highlights: Division II second-team All-Northeast Inland District. ... First-team All-Suburban League American Conference. ... Key blocker for offense that averaged school-record 44.5 points, as well as 402.9 yards. ... Had 26 tackles (4½ for loss, 3½ sacks) for defense that allowed Medina County lows of 7.5 points and 170.3 yards per game.
Hornets coach Mike Gibbons on Bendaui: "Cody played on the line with a great get off on both sides of the ball. He played with great leverage and use of his hands. Cody was a great leader for our team and always pushed himself and his teammates."

Class: Senior.
 Height: 6-foot-1. Weight: 230.
Highlights: Division I honorable mention All-Ohio. ... First-team All-Northeast Inland District and Greater Cleveland Conference. ... Top blocker for improved offense that averaged 21.4 points and 270.3 yards. ... Productive part-time defensive tackle who had 16 tackles (2½ for loss, sack) and fumble recovery.
Blue Devils coach Kolo Carter on Hayes: "In a position that gets little glory, he only cared about contributing to the success of our program. He ensured that his position group got better every week and taught me so much about the importance of establishing the line of scrimmage at all levels of football."

Highlights: Division II honorable mention All-Northeast Inland District. ... First-team All-Suburban League National Conference. ... Three-year starter at H-back moved to right tackle for parts of season due to injuries. ... Top blocker for team that averaged 43.8 points on Medina County-leading 434.6 yards. ... Rotated at defensive end.
Grizzlies coach Justin Todd on Leavitt: "One of our hardest workers, his blocking ability as a tight end allowed us to move him to offensive line in some of our biggest games. His strength at defensive end was evident, as he ate up multiple blockers when singled up."

Highlights: Division II honorable mention All-Ohio. ... First-team All-Northeast Inland District. ... Suburban League American Conference Specialist of Year. ... Made 4-of-7 field goals, with two covering more than 40 yards. ... Hammered Medina County-record 43 touchbacks in 63 attempts. ... Made 48 extra points. ... No. 5 kicker in country for class.
Hornets coach Mike Gibbons on Kowza: "Jonah works at his craft daily and takes a lot of pride in what he is doing. Jonah has a very bright future ahead of himself."
