- Several Greater Akron high school athletic conferences will see changes in membership starting in the 2026-27 school year.
- The Metro Athletic Conference will expand to 10 schools, adding Cuyahoga Falls, Kent Roosevelt, and Tallmadge.
- The Suburban League will realign its National and American conferences, with some schools moving between them for football.
- The Principals Athletic Conference will grow to eight teams with the addition of Coventry.
- The City Series, Federal League, and North Coast Conference will have no changes to their current membership.

In football only: Two schools moved from the National Conference. Two schools added.
